2022 Application Overview & Submission **Qualification Requirements**

Thank you for your interest in the CCAH Education Scholarship. The Scholarship Program was established by the California Council for Affordable Housing (CCAH) to promote education and expand opportunities for residents of affordable housing in California.

CCAH will award four total scholarships:

- ⇒ **Two scholarships, JC or trade**
 - **\$1,000 award (2 increments - \$500 per semester)**
- ⇒ **Two scholarships, State or (4) year**
 - **\$2,000 award (2 increments - \$1,000 per semester)**

Scholarship recipients' semester awards are contingent upon the recipient's continued qualification: CCAH property residency, 3.0 or above GPA, full time student and household income less than 60% of AMI. CCAH welcomes applications from students residing in CCAH member properties.

A Selection Committee comprised of CCAH Board Members and CCAH Staff will review the applications. The awarding of the scholarships will be based solely on the objective judgment of the Selection Committee as to which candidates demonstrate the greatest potential for utilizing the resources offered by the scholarship. CCAH prohibits the awarding of any scholarship to a relative of any member of the Selection Committee.

This application and supporting related documentation must be fully completed and submitted to be considered by the Scholarship Selection Committee by **July 15, 2022**.

APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS

Member Qualifications: In order for the student to qualify, the CCAH member must be current on their dues in the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

Student Qualifications: Student must have the following qualifications to be considered:

1. Be a current resident (or subsequent to the award, family is a current resident) of a CCAH member – owned or managed property;
2. Be a candidate for graduation or high school graduate or equivalent (i.e. GED);
3. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or above as evidenced by recent transcripts;
4. Be accepted at or enrolled as a full time (12 units or more) student at an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university or an accredited vocational education program as evidenced by enrollment of courses;
5. Household income must not be greater than 60% of AMI as evidenced by signature on the application by the manager, property manager or owner.
